Preliminary Results of Superior Industries' Annual Meeting Indicate All Company Nominees Elected to Board

VAN NUYS, CALIFORNIA – **August 15, 2014** – **Superior Industries International, Inc. (NYSE:SUP)**, the largest manufacturer of aluminum wheels for passenger cars and light-duty vehicles in North America, today reported that based on preliminary results, all of the Company's director nominees—Paul J. Final certified voting results are expected to be made available early next week.
